**Joy.** The children will be learning to feel joyful when their potatoes and plants start to grow and share this with parents when they take them home.

**Patience** The children will learn about patience when waiting for the seeds to grow.

**Love** The children will learn to make links between how their actions impact on others and link it to the story of Goldilocks
