Houses and Homes



This half term we will be starting a new topic learning all about different houses and homes. This will include looking at our local area, learning about different types of home and in particular

studying castles and their special features.

In English the children will be embedding all of the skills that they have been taught so far this year. We will be encouraging the children to use a range of sentence types independently including list sentences, commands, explanation sentences and questions. We will also be encouraging the children to use a range of adverbs and suffixes to make their work as engaging as possible for the reader. The children will also be reviewing their work to see where they can make improvements. This is a great skill and will really help them when they move into Key Stage Two.

In Maths we will be revising all four operations multiplication, division, addition and subtraction ensuring that we are really confident using these methods. We will also recap using the inverse and estimation to check our answers.

In topic, we will be looking at features of different houses and homes. We will learn about how people lived in the past and build our own model houses. We will also be visiting Warwick Castle at the end of term to learn about lives of people in the past and how they lived during this time period.
