## Family First: Behaviour Secrets for Parents!

Is your child's behaviour at home sometimes challenging? Would you like some advice on how to manage difficult behaviour?

If so, we would like to invite you to join us to take part in a series of short sessions called 'Family First' created by Beacon School Support. Family First guides parents through the behaviour secrets every parent should know. It is designed to be a step-by-step guide to managing behaviour in the home. - 10. How to manage screen time 13th June
- 11. How to deal with strong emotions 20<sup>th</sup> June
