

Parent Survey - July 2015

We had 45 responses out of a total of 150 families, which is 30% of the families. Although this is down on last year (42% responded in 2014), we would like to thank all those that returned the form, and the positive opinions and constructive comments of the school.

100% of parents felt their child was happy at school and felt safe. This is important to Holly Hill and all the staff work hard to ensure all children matter. We are really pleased with this result.

Unfortunately we did not receive any comments on this, so we will have to monitor this going forward.

I have a clear idea of the roles and responsibilities of the school's governors eg. in ensuring the head teacher is running the school well	81.7%	5.3%	13.1%	The negative response has increase since 2014. All parents are provided a copy of the Annual report at parents evening, this is also available on the website under the parents page. We have 2 parent governors, and will look at using them to liaise with other parents in school. We will look at how the information is provided in the report for 2015.

I am pleased with the amount that the school pays towards the cost of school trips	84.7%	12.8%	2.5%	We introduced a blanket trip charge of £5 per child last year, with the school paying for the balance. The negative response on this is a little disappointing, and we will monitor going forward.

School Meals at Holly Hill are healthy	86.7%	8.3%	5.0%	Our school meals have to meet strict criteria's as per the Food standards. The meals are checked and audited externally to make sure they meet the standards. Please speak to the school office if you wish for a copy of the menus.

I think the school drinks are reasonably priced	92.2%	3.8%	4.0%	We now offer free milk for all children, which is paid for by school, and offers a healthy drink at breaktime.

Holly Hill helps me to help my child take part in out of school clubs or sports activities	84.2%	9.0%	6.8%	The school runs a variety of after school activities at different times of the year. Unfortunately, they are often oversubscribed, so we try and allocate places fairly.

The school is good at recognising and celebrating pupils achievements and successes	91.7%	5.6%	2.8%	We have listened to views of parents, and in September 2015 have introduced a new Achievement system. Children receive a certificate and recognition on the day, and their picture is put on the Award wall in the hall. We will monitor the success of this.
