Our topic this half term is...

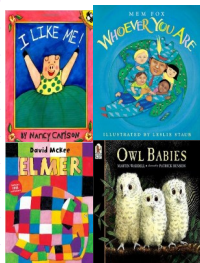
Me, You, Us!

Please ensure you pay for your child's lunches each week.

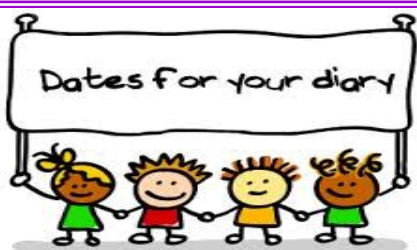
*Lunch for two days is **£2.40** per week.
